- i. a justice of the peace or a bail justice;
- ii. a public notary;
- iii. an Australian lawyer (within the meaning of the Legal Profession Act 2004 (Vic);
- iv. a clerk to an Australian lawyer;
- v. the prothonotary or a deputy prothonotary of the Supreme Court, the registrar or a deputy registrar of the County Court, the principal registrar of the Magistrates' Court or a registrar or deputy registrar of the Magistrates' Court;
- vi. the registrar of probates or an assistant registrar of probates;
- vii. the associate to a judge of the Supreme Court or of the County Court;
- viii. the associate of an Associate Judge of the Supreme Court or of an associate judge of the County Court;
- ix. a person registered as a patent attorney under Chapter 20 of the *Patents Act* 1990 (Vic) of the Commonwealth;
- x. a member of the police force;
- xi. the sheriff or a deputy sheriff;
- xii. a member or former member of either House of the Parliament of Victoria;
- xiii. a member or former member of either House of the Parliament of the Commonwealth;
- xiv. a councillor of a municipality;
- xv. a senior officer of a Council as defined in the Local Government Act 1989 (Vic);
- xvi. a person registered under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law to practise in the medical profession (other than as a student);
- xvii. a person registered under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law:
 - A. to practise in the dental profession as a dentist (other than as a student); and
 - B. in the dentists division of that profession;
- xviii. a veterinary practitioner;
- xix. a person registered under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law to practise in the pharmacy profession (other than as a student);
- xx. a principal in the teaching service;
- xxi. the manager of an authorised deposit-taking institution;
- xxii. a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia or the Australian Society of Accountants or the Institute of Public Accountants;

- xxiii. the secretary of a building society;
- xxiv. a minister of religion authorised to celebrate marriages;
- xxv. a Victorian Inspectorate Officer within the meaning of the *Victorian Inspectorate Act* 2011 (Vic);
- xxvi. a person employed under Part 3 of the *Public Administration Act* 2004 (Vic) with a classification that is prescribed as a classification to which this section applies or who holds office in a statutory authority with such a classification;
- xxvii. an IBAC Officer within the meaning of the *Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission Act* 2011 (Vic); and
- xxviii. a fellow of the Institute of Legal Executives (Victoria).
